CLUB RULES

These are available from the office on request. Our rules are designed to set standards of conduct and behaviour to ensure members and guests feel comfortable using any facility of the Club at any time. They are reviewed regularly.

THE CLUBHOUSE

All Members are welcome to use the Clubhouse at all times, including the bar and our restaurant, when they are open. Your membership swipe card can be credited with money at the bar (by cash or debit card) and payment for drinks using the card receives a 15% discount.

Golf clothes and golf shoes may be worn in the Spike Bar only. We want you to feel relaxed when you come here and so in the Lounge Bar and Restaurant smart casual clothes are permitted, excluding golf shoes of course. And we do expect you to change out of dirty golf clothes before eating in our restaurant. Hats should be removed on entering the Clubhouse. Details of the full dress code are available from the office and are on the notice board.

Mobile phones must be switched off on the course and used only in emergencies. Considerate use of mobile phones is allowed in the Clubhouse but we prefer that members and guests take their calls outside.

The Clubhouse usually opens around 8.00am throughout the year. Bar hours are as follows:

BAR / RESTAURANT

The club has two bar areas (Spike and Lounge). Golf shoes are only permitted in the Spike bar. The Lounge Bar handles visitors for lunch and all private function visitors. There is a Bar menu offered between 9am and 6pm. The club has a regular Sunday lunch sitting from 12pm – 3.30pm. Sunday lunch is popular and booking are advised. Guests are very welcome.

MEMBER COMMUNICATION

Our main communication is by email. Information to members is sent out by the management of Sudbury Golf Club and the various section captains. For those without email, copies can be obtained from the office. General notices, social function details and competition information are displayed on the notice-boards throughout the clubhouse. We also have a weekly e-newsletter which keeps you informed of what is happening.

LOCKER ROOMS, GOLF BAG AND TROLLEY STORAGE

Renting a locker in the changing rooms is by arrangement with the office. The lockers are rented on a yearly basis. Access to the Clubhouse and locker rooms are by a 4 digit code.

PERSONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Club Personal Liability Insurance gives members up to £5m cover for accidental injury to another person or accidental damage to third party property if a member is found to be legally responsible. The insurance does not cover golf equipment – Members will still need personal cover for this (normally through their Home Insurance policy). Members owning ride-on golf vehicles must obtain personal motor cover. Details of the insurance cover provided by the Club can be obtained from the Golf Office.

GUESTS

All Members may invite guests to the Club. Playing members may also introduce playing guests. The member must play golf with the guest(s) and is responsible for the conduct and dress code of their guest(s) whilst at the Club. A member may only introduce one guest up to 6 times per year and no more than 3 at any one time, unless with prior permission.

Member's Guest Green Fees are as follows:

Monday – Friday:	£20.00
Saturday & Sunday:	After 11.30: £25.00

If the Pro Shop is closed, a Green fee must be paid in advance in the Bar before playing. There may be special offers from time to time and these are communicated to members by email and via notice boards.

CLUB V1 -MEN'S & LADIES HANDICAPS

The competition and handicaps are administered by the ClubV1 'Handicap' software. This is accessed on the main computers in the office and through the PSI terminals in the Pro shop and Spike Bar. Member records are 'linked' with the ClubV1 'Membership' software.

'HOW DID I DO' WEBSITE

When members join the club they should register with the HDID website in order to access start sheets and to register their handicap. Registration is free and easy and is explained in the Welcome Pack they receive on joining.

HANDICAPS

Member's handicaps can be viewed on the HDID website and on the PSI terminals in the Spike Bar or Pro Shop. On joining the Club, if a member has an official EG handicap, the General Manager will enter it onto the golf administration system (ClubV1).

When playing in competitions, players return cards by entering the score details on the PSI (Player Score Input) machines in the Spike Bar or Pro Shop and their handicaps are amended automatically. If a new member does not have an official handicap, they need to complete 3 rounds of golf, marked by a member to receive a handicap before they are eligible to enter any competitions. The professional must be notified of their intention prior to play. If a member needs a Handicap Certificate at any time they can print one through their HDID page or contact the office or professional. The Club has a handicap committee with whom any queries can be addressed. This committee meets once a year (usually January) to review member's handicaps.

CLUB SECTIONS

The Club has active Men's, Ladies and junior sections. Each section has a member who arranges golf and social events in liaison with the Club's management. Within the Men's section, there are 5 sub-groups, each of which has regular competitions and fixtures. These are:

- Tiger (7 – 9 handicap)
- Foxes (10 – 18 handicap)
- Rabbits (19+ handicap)
- Seniors and Vets (Age 60+ and not in full time employment)

The ladies have Silver and Bronze sections for matches whose handicaps are as follows;

- Silver (0–20)
- Bronze (21+)

COMPETITIONS

There is a full fixture list of competitions throughout the year. A Club diary is produced and made available around December. It highlights various club competitions and club matches for all sections. It also gives dates and times of club social functions. These are subject to change and any changes are notified to members via email or the weekly newsletter.

All competitions have reserved tee times which are booked through the HDID website. Tee sheets go 'live' online usually around 14 days prior to the competition date. These tee times can be booked through the HDID website at home on your PC or on the PSI terminals in the Pro Shop or Spike Bar.

Booking a tee time on line does not enter you into the competition it simply reserves your tee time. All Competition entry is on the day of the competition and is also done through the PSI terminals in the Pro Shop or Spike Bar. There is usually an entry fee of £3 for a competition and an optional sweep of a £2. This entry money is taken directly from your swipe card so no cash is necessary.

Competitions are 'closed' at the end of the competition or the next day and the results are then posted onto the HDID website and hard copies are put on the notice boards in either the men's or ladies locker room. Any winnings are dealt with by the General Manager who allocates those winnings to the member's swipe cards.

Young Adult (22-29), Age Group (18-21)

- Use of the golf course and all associated facilities on all days of the week
- Eligible to play in all adult competitions subject to handicap
- Can attend some club social functions

Juniors (10-17)

- Use of the golf course and all associated facilities on all days of the week
- Eligible to play in all junior and some adult competitions subject to handicap
- Can attend some club social functions

- Social members can use all Clubhouse facilities, 7 days a week.
- Can attend all club social functions
